Our plan is to have a display space for wet paintings during the entire MLF so paintings can be dropped off as they are complete - details are still being worked out as to where this space will be. We will be looking into sponsors for this event and will let you know if there will be "competition elements" & "purchase prize".

11:00 AM– Noon – Drop your remaining paintings to the Wet Paint Room - TBA Paintings must be framed and ready to hang with your completed paperwork (found in your check-in packet) If you have a commissioned painting, please let us know at check-in so it can be marked as a Sold/Commissioned piece- *checks for any commissioned pieces must still adhere to the Wet Paint Sale 20% commission even if they are scheduled to be painted at a later date.*

Noon – 3:00 PM– Paint the Town Wet Paint Sale - space will be limited so we are asking for no more than 4 submissions per artist (all Monroe County subjects) and half must be “wet”.

Checks for purchases will be written directly to the artist but will be held until the end of the sale. A 20% commission check (or cash) on all purchases, written to Monroeville Main Street, will be at due at pick up.
